## **Call for Abstract**

The Scientific Committee of the World Association of Sexual Health (WAS) invites all participants to submit abstracts for oral or poster presentations at the 26th Congress of WAS.

- Presenters may indicate their preference for oral presentation, poster presentation, or symposium.
- Abstracts should be submitted in **English**.
- Abstracts can only be submitted electronically.
- Accepted abstracts will be published in the Abstract Book (digital format) only if registration and payment of registration fee have been received.

**Abstract Submission Deadline: 30 April 2023**

## **Abstract submission guidelines**

Please follow the submission guidelines carefully. Abstracts that do not follow the guidelines will not be considered. Corrected abstracts cannot be accepted.

Authors will be informed of the acceptance of their abstracts by email.

- Submitted abstracts will be evaluated on scientific merit and originality by the International Scientific Committee.
- Abstracts must be written in English, and, if accepted, the presentations will also be in English.
- The total number of abstracts allowed to be submitted by the same author is 3.

The WAS Scientific Committee will decide on the final format (poster or oral/symposium) of the presentation. Accepted abstracts will be assigned for presentation in an online virtual session or a moderated poster session by the WAS scientific Committee. High quality abstracts in select categories may be chosen for presentation in a Symposium Session.

Abstracts not selected for Oral Presentation, Symposium, or Moderated Poster Sessions will be considered for presentation(s) as a regular poster. Please check the box if you do NOT wish your abstract to be considered for this option.

# **Preparation of Abstracts**

#### SIZE

Abstracts are limited to 300 words. The abstract title, names of authors and affiliations are not included in the word count. Please do not submit any tables or figures in the abstract.

#### TITLE

The title should clearly describe the topic and contain no abbreviations. The title should be as succinct as possible, preferably no longer than 10 words.

#### **AUTHORS**

All author names should be included. List the primary author's full name, followed by the other authors' names. Spell out completely the names of all authors using full first name, middle/initial and last name (maintain consistency in authors' names on multiple abstracts to avoid duplication in the Author Index). Authors' affiliations should be indicated by numbered superscripts with the name of the respective institution(s), city, and country typed in upper and lower case and single-spaced without using full-stops.

## **Presenting Author**

If the author(s) of the abstract is an employee(s) of or has a financial relationship with the commercial interest which controls the content of the presentation, then he/she cannot be the presenting author. However, principal investigators responsible for research and development are permitted to present as long as they resolve their COI and as long as they are not employees of the commercial interest. In all printed publications the name of the presenting author will be <u>underscored</u>.

**Please note:** As of 20 June 2023, no changes to the Presenting Author will be made in the Program/Abstract Publication.

  - Please type the abstract single-spaced with no indentations, starting each paragraph on a new line. Do not include non-standard symbols, as they will not be recognized and may be displayed wrongly.
  - The inclusion of results, or perspectives or new hypotheses is expected for, in particular, abstracts reporting on quantitative and qualitative studies.
  - Standard abbreviations may be used but should be spelled out the first time and followed by the introduction of the abbreviation between parentheses.
  - Proprietary names of drugs are allowed only with the symbol ™; generic and molecule names should be used preferably.

### **SOURCE OF FUNDING**

The source of grant support must be indicated. If there is no support "None" must be listed. This is a required field in the submission process.

Abstracts deemed to be submitted for marketing purposes only will not be accepted.

### CONFLICT OF INTEREST AND DISCLOSURE STATEMENT

Any potential conflict of interest must be disclosed. The submission process will not allow abstracts to be submitted without this information being completed for each author listed on the abstract.
